Abstract: David F. Bolger is the president of the Bolger Foundation, which has provided numerous grants and other donations to local institutions such as libraries and healthcare facilities. His philanthropic efforts extend outside of New Jersey to Florida, Iowa and Massachusetts. David is the founder and chairman of Bolger & Co., Inc which is a real estate and investment firm in Ridgewood New Jersey. The collection spans from 1997-2012, with the bulk of the collection dating 2000-2009. It includes correspondence, newspaper clippings, photographs, his high school yearbook, awards and biographical information on David Bolger and his donations. The Bolger Foundation has a philanthropic mission and the collection illustrates the breadth of their charitable donations.

## David F. Bolger History (August 12, 1932 – December 29, 2018):

David F. Bolger was educated at Northfield Mt. Hermon in Mt. Hermon, Massachusetts. He continued his studies and worked his way through college at the University of Pittsburgh, in the Pennsylvania steel mills. David Bolger founded and was President of the Bolger & Co. Inc. in 1966. The Company is a real estate and investment firm located in Ridgewood New Jersey. At the same time he was the President of The Bolger Foundation, which serves as a philanthropic organization. David Bolger established the Foundation in 2000. Through the Foundation, David Bolger had supported various organizations including healthcare and mental health institutions, programs serving disadvantaged youths and senior citizens, churches, conservation programs, libraries, and other educational organizations and has donated over 75 million dollars.

### **Scope and Content Note:**

The collection is 4 linear ft housed in four mss. boxes and two flat mss. boxes. The entire collection spans the years 1997-2012, with the bulk of information pertaining to the years 2000-2009. The types of documents within the collection consist of office memos and correspondence, reports and analysis of Foundation donations, newspaper clippings, awards recognizing philanthropic donations, pamphlets on various charity events, photographs from events, brief biographical clippings, magazines, award plaques, posterboards for Ridgewood Public Library exhibits, photograph album for scrapbook, and donated frames. The collection has four series: Biography; Projects; David F. Bolger Foundation; and Objects. Within these four series are numerous sub-series that are listed below.

The Biography series documents the life and accomplishments of David Bolger and his contributions. There are files on his donations, honors he has received, his humor and photographs. These papers cover a wide range of information on his mission as a philanthropist and his impact on the community. David passed away on December 29, 2018, and there is a folder in the Biography series that contains materials on his impact on the community along with his obituary. The series spans the years of 2001-2018.

The Projects Files series organizes information on the numerous projects in which <u>David Bolger and his Foundation</u> have invested. Therefore, the papers within this file contain information on projects from numerous states: Florida, Iowa, Massachusetts, New Jersey and Texas; specific information on the projects within those states; more information on honors and donations; and statistics on his donations and how they affected the community. The series involves the years of 1997-2012.

<u>The David F. Bolger Foundation</u> series contains paperwork on numerous aspects of the Foundation including its administration, correspondence, goals, and honors. The series describes the <u>David F. Bolger Foundation</u> and how it functions as a philanthropic institution. The series involves the years of 2000-2009.

Finally, the Objects are the fourth series in this collection. These files date from 2009-2011, and provide illustrations of David Bolger's various donations. The objects vary from an empty album (meant for scrapbooking his life) to plaques honoring him, poster boards portraying his donations to the Ridgewood Public Library, and frames that provide a glimpse into his life.
